

YSCIR COMMUNITY COUNCIL ANNUAL REPORT
APRIL 2023 TO MARCH 2024

Yscir Community Council consists of 7 councillors, elected by the local community every 5 years (with an election due in May 2027). The Council meets 6 times a year with additional meetings, if required, to consider planning applications. Although not a member of the council, county councillor Iain McIntosh has attended its meetings and been very active in helping the council to get work done in the area, by Powys County Council.

Almost all the income of the Council comes through the precept, £1,344 being received in 2024/25. The Council spent £1,749 in 2024/25. The precept and expenditure were low because we currently have no clerk. No concerns were raised by the internal and external audits for the 23/24 year.

The Council are maintaining 2 defibrillators in the community in Aberbran (outside Ty Torlan) and Battle (opposite Heol y Garreg). In addition, there are defibrillators at Cradoc School (near front entrance) and at Cradoc Golf Club (rear of clubhouse).

Speedwatch has continued to try and make the roads safer in our villages.
